The Fourth Degree (Patriotism) is the highest Degree in the Knights of Columbus. Third Degree Knights become eligible once they have been a Knight for six (6) months.

With the exception of priests and active military and full time law enforcement officers and full time firefighting officers in full dress uniform, a black tuxedo, bowtie, cummerbund and white tuxedo shirt with regular collar is required to join the 4th Degree. You are strongly urged to buy a tuxedo rather than rent for two reasons. (1) A rental tux costs around 1/2 the price of a tux. (2) You will have many opportunities to wear your tux as an active Sir Knight. Check out prices locally and check out www.chilbert.com. Chilbert. The designated KC tuxedo supplier will temporarily sell their most popular \$199 woven polyester tux for \$179 or their \$285 all wool tuxes for \$249 to Iowa Knights only.

Both tuxedos are KC Approved and are complete including shirt, cummerbund, pre-tied bowtie, formal hose, suspenders, cuff links, stud set and travel garment bag. To get the reduced price, you must call them at 1-800-BUY-A-TUX (1-800-289-2889) and tell them you are an Iowa Knight.

Supreme has set the exemplification fee at \$70.00. Candidates will receive a social baldric, Fourth Degree Pin and one (1) banquet ticket. I am also including an American Flag Pin and certificate.
